God Promises a Ruler From Bethlehem



Micah was a prophet who lived about 700 years before Jesus was born. However, he told the people of Israel of the coming of Jesus. First, we read about the sin of Jacob and all of Israel. He told the people that the king (Jesus) would be born in Bethlehem and would bring them peace.

Our reading today ends with what God wants of us:

He has told you, O mortal, what is good,
and what does the Lord require of you
but to do justice and to love kindness
and to walk humbly with your God?

Conversation starters:

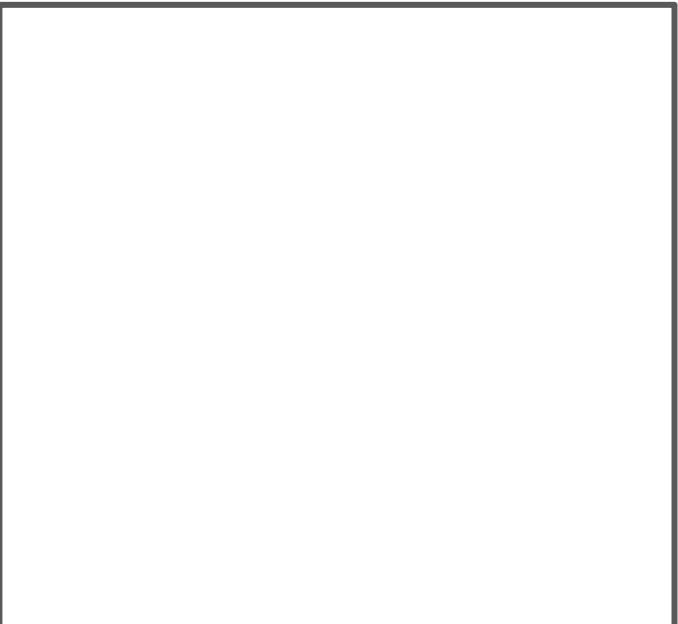
- Why do you think Micah reminds the people of Jacob and the sins of Israel?
