Matthew 25:31-46

Parable of the Last Judgement



This week's parable is called the sheep and the goats. Jesus tells us that at the final judgement, all people will be sorted—sheep—disciples of Jesus at his right and the goats—not disciples—at his left. The sheep will be taken to God's kingdom. He says that they helped him when he was in need. When the people ask when they did that, he said, when you help others, you are helping him. Those who did not help, are not going to God's kingdom.

Conversation starters:

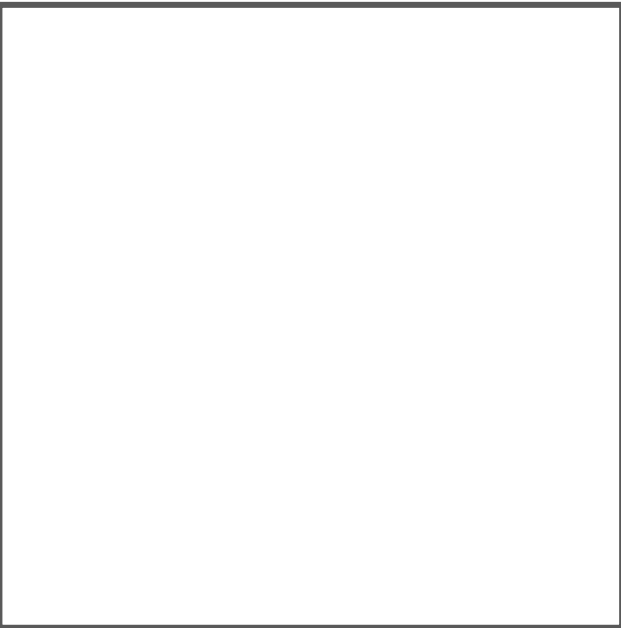
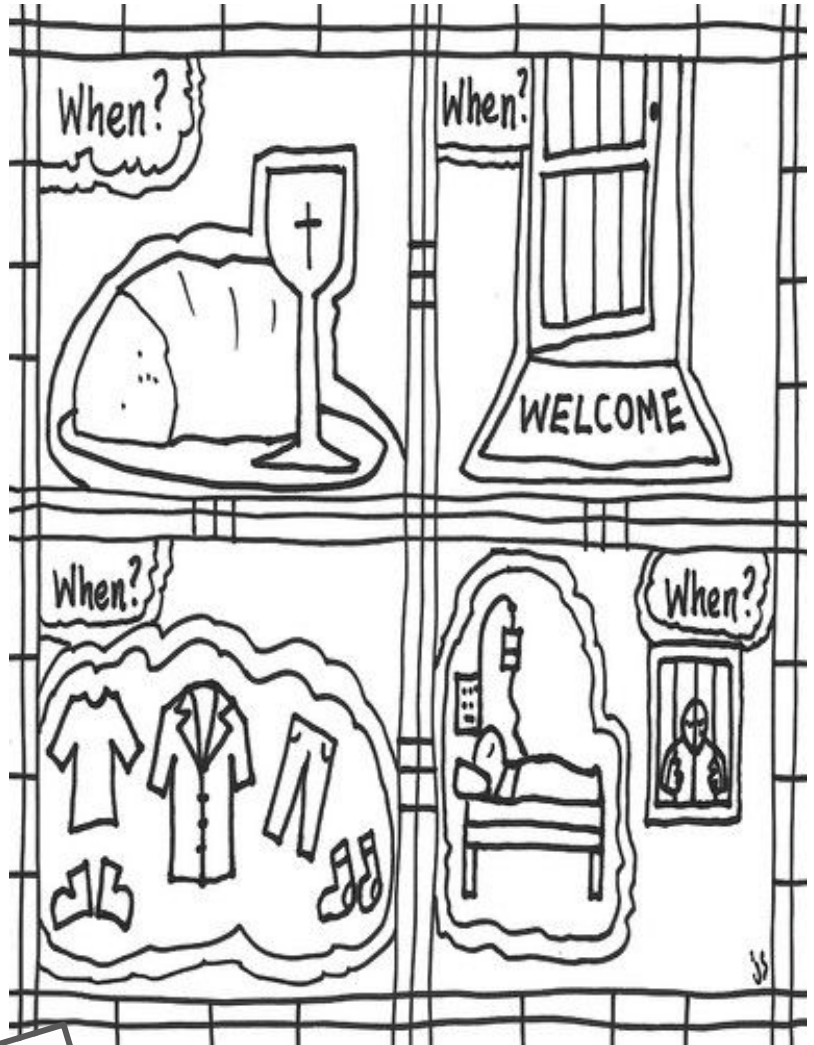
- What do you know about how sheep and goats act?

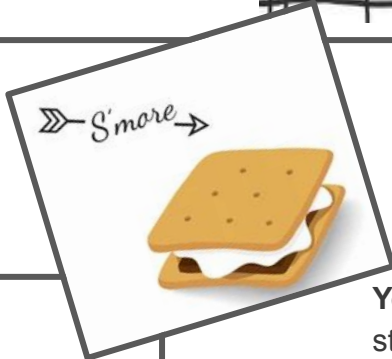
